

WOMEN IN RELIGION

Peg Carlson is our new CMD Women in Religion Chair and has already provided the first CMD Women in Religion Conference. Womanspirit, held at North Shore Unitarian Church on January 20-22, featured Elinor Artman and Shelley Jackson Denham from Cincinnati and was a great success.

Plans are already underway for a 2nd conference to be held the last weekend in January of 1990. It will be held in the Chicago area, but in 1991 and 1992, the conference will move north and south, so that women from throughout the district can attend more easily.

"Woman Quest: Embracing the Sacred, Expanding the Circle" will be the theme of an upcoming convocation at Lake Geneva, Wisconsin, April 20-25, 1990. The purpose of this gathering is to develop a UU women's agenda for the 21st century.

Three tracks are planned: process groups which will develop the agenda; spiritual disciplines offered daily on feminist theology, meditation, etc.; and, individual workshops. Holly Near will be doing the closing concert.

Conference planners need 80 people to do workshops, lead the spiritual disciplines and facilitate the process.


Look for fliers beginning in April and also at GA in June.


